Renovations well underway

The past year was busy around WLMH with many large projects taking place at the same time. Thank you to everyone who has been working to create a safe hospital for patients, staff and physicians, until a new one is built. We're 75% complete!

Completed work:

- Two boilers installed
- One diesel generator installed
- Fuel tanks installed
- Front and central elevators updated
- New air handling units – L&D, ED, laboratory medicine
- Obstetrics renovations
- New fire alarm upgrade completed

Next steps:

- Commissioning of second generator – April
- Installation of cooling towers – May
- OR and endoscopy renovations - August
- Lighting upgrade - 85% complete
